Further requests would be run in the parish news and on the Times face book page.  <b>Easter Market:</b> The April market would fall on Easter Sunday. Traders would be approached at the next market to gauge interest and if sufficient interest and a driver and volunteers were available a market would be held.  <b>Product:</b> Sales were low and at this stage no further items would be ordered. Some shoppers could be used as a promotional item at a selected market.  <b>Community Stall:</b> A request from a neighbouring village to use the stall for a fund raiser was declined as the sale of jam would be in direct competition with traders.</p>
