18/77	<p><b>Declarations of Interest in matters to be discussed:</b> None</p>
	<p><b>Reports from District Councillors.</b> BCC Cllr. Chilver confirmed that in view of the implementation period for the Unitary Authority, the District and Parish Council elections would be deferred until 2020. The new authority would be called the Buckinghamshire Council.</p> <p>The surface fault on the Great Horwood Road was to have been done by this time. Work on the resurfacing of Church Walk and Church Street was delayed by the need to repair drains.</p> <p>AVDC Cllr Monger confirmed the progress on the Unitary Authority and added that a further announcement was expected in the near future.</p>
18/78	<p><b>Committees and Reports from District and County Councillors.</b></p> <p><b>Amenities:</b> No matters were raised.</p> <p><b>Development:</b> Members were encouraged to raise a personal objection to the proposed development off Great Horwood Road as it did not conform to the Neighbourhood Plan. The Committee, as consultee, had lodged an objection. Members noted the proposed solar farm at East Claydon</p>
18/79	<p><b>Current Strategic Issues</b></p> <p><b>Growth Corridor:</b> A letter had been sent to Highways England to seek confirmation of stakeholder status and an indication of how WTC would be kept informed of developments as well as the proper channel for engaging with them.</p> <p><b>Unitary Authority</b> There was no further information to that reported by District councillors as above.</p> <p><b>East West Rail</b> There was no further information to report.</p> <p><b>Neighbourhood Plan</b> A further review meeting would be held on January 22<sup>nd</sup>.</p> <p><b>Community Centre</b> The summary report from Frankhams was awaited. It was expected that there would be time to circulate the report to councillors before the consultant made a presentation to Council at the February meeting.</p> <p><b>28 High St.</b> No matters were raised.</p> <p><b>Strategy Meeting</b> Members considered a proposal to hold a strategy meeting to discuss issues such as the proposed Community Centre in terms of the longer-term issues that had to be addressed once a site and plan were determined. The Clerk was asked to investigate possible dates in February to discussed items on which reports and background information were available.</p>
