<b>A19/57</b>	<b>Minutes of Meeting</b> held on Thursday 19 <sup>th</sup> September 2019: the Committee RESOLVED that the minutes be signed as a true record. <b>Matters Arising:</b> None.

<b>A19/58</b> <b>A19/59</b>	<b>Clerk's Report:</b> Members discussed the Clerks report on the operation of devolved services, street furniture, playground, CCTV, outdoor gym, recreation ground, burial ground, allotments, and the Public Hall Car Park. <b>Burial Ground</b> - The Committee discussed various drafts of the revised rules and RESOLVED that Cllr Castle and the Clerk prepare a further draft for the Committee's next meeting. The Committee further RESOLVED to allow East West Rail to use the Burial Ground car park to lift equipment onto the track bed.
<b>A19/60</b>	<b>Devolved Services</b> - Members discussed BCC's offer of an extension to the Devolved Services contract and, while minded to agree to an extension, deferred any decision until the Committee's next meeting. The Clerk will circulate the draft contract. <b>Recreation Ground</b> - Members noted correspondence from a resident about goal netting. The Committee discussed correspondence from Winslow Sports Club regarding waste collections from the clubhouse and RESOLVED that the Council continues to pay its share of the general waste disposal cost.
<b>A19/61</b>	<b>Public Hall Car Park</b> - Members noted that cleaning is arranged for 9 <sup>th</sup> December 2019.
<b>A19/62</b>	<b>Street Scene</b> - The Committee RESOLVED to extend the current AVDC dog bin emptying contract until 31 <sup>st</sup> March 2020. Members discussed the High Street, northbound bus shelter and RESOLVED that the Clerk should write to the CCG to discuss using NHS land to unblock the footway. The Committee further
<b>A19/63</b>	RESOLVED that any replacement litter bins for the cycle path be of the 'Neptune' design and in green.
<b>A19/64</b>	<b>Pétanque Terrain</b> - The committee noted that the official opening will take place on 23 <sup>rd</sup> November 2019.
<b>A19/65</b> <b>A19/66</b>	<b>Tomkins Park</b> - The Committee RESOLVED to purchase two additional benches to face the pétanque terrain, and that the cost be taken from the wider Amenities budget. The Committee further RESOLVED that the Council's contractor be employed to remove three dead trees from the Park. Members discussed the planting of new trees, requested that the Clerk circulates a planting scheme and RESOLVED that the trees should be planted at the earliest opportunity.
