**PLANNING MATTERS**

**Planning Appeal: APP/J0405/W/22/3303420, Land South of Buckingham Road:** Outline development of up to 60 residential dwellings (a minimum of 50% affordable) with associated open space, landscaping, highway and drainage infrastructure.

D22/97 The Committee considered a draft response prepared by Cllrs Bishopp, Cawdell and Slevin, along with amendments suggested by Cllrs Bishopp and van de Poll, and RESOLVED: (a) to oppose the appeal, which is contrary to the Winslow Neighbourhood Plan, (b) that the Clerk should submit a statement to the Planning Inspectorate, setting out WTCs objection to the appeal, (c) that Cllrs Slevin and Cawdell be delegated to finalise the submission, and (d) that the Clerk confirms to Buckinghamshire Council that, whilst WTC does not intend to appear at the hearing, it is willing to appear in support of Buckinghamshire Council's case if necessary.
